Job Summary:

Responsible for the inspection of incoming waste and the placement and management of such waste in the landfill. Operate various types of heavy equipment. Assist in performing scale-house duties, such as weighing incoming vehicles, determining fees, and accepting and receipting payments.

Essential Functions:

- 1. Performs the duties and exercise the responsibilities described in the Landfill Operator description.
- 2. Assist in gathering and reporting information and data required by State and Federal regulatory agencies. Complete required landfill reports.
- 3. Ability to calculate slopes and elevations.
- 4. Extensive knowledge of the operations and maintenance of heavy equipment.
- 5. Extensive knowledge of local, state, and federal laws and regulations pertaining to the operations of a landfill.
- 6. Keep confidential information confidential.
- 7. Perform duties in extreme weather conditions.
- 8. Report to work within thirty-five (35) minutes for emergencies under normal driving conditions, as required.

- 9. Work the days and hours necessary to perform all assigned responsibilities and tasks. Must be available (especially during regular business hours or shifts) to communicate with subordinates, supervisors, customers, vendors and any other persons or organizations with whom interaction is required to accomplish work and employer goals.
- 10. Punctual and timely in meeting all requirements of performance, including, but not limited to, attendance standards and work deadlines; beginning and ending assignments on time; and scheduled work breaks, where applicable.
- 11. Work extended hours in an emergency.
- 12. Perform other work which is consistent with the essential functions of the job.
- 13. Perform other duties as assigned.

Education and Special License(s)/Certifications:

High school diploma or equivalent.

Must be at least eighteen (18) years of age.

Must possess a valid driver's license and maintain an insurable driving record.

Possession of or ability to obtain a Class B commercial driver's license (CDL) with proper endorsements within sixty (60) days from date of hire.

Experience:

At least three (3) years of landfill operation experience. Operation of heavy equipment, motor graders, and dump truck driving skills. (Breaks in service of no more than ninety (90) days shall be considered *de minimums* and shall not be considered in calculating the consecutive years.)
