Job Summary:					
Assist in a variety of entry-level duties related to tree, weed, and litter control and removal.					

Essential Functions:

- 1. Perform litter control and removal in the Beatrice Area Solid Waste Agency (BASWA) Landfill and along the fence line of the property.
- 2. Perform mowing, weed removal, and tree trimming as directed. Control unwanted vegetation.
- 3. May perform duties such as painting items and cleaning and washing vehicles.
- 4. Establish and maintain effective working relationships with City officials, fellow employees, patrons, and members of the public.
- 5. Keep confidential information confidential.
- 6. Perform duties in extreme weather conditions.
- 7. Report to work within thirty-five (35) minutes for emergencies under normal driving conditions, as required.
- 8. The employee must work the days and hours necessary to perform all assigned responsibilities and tasks. Must be available (especially during regular business hours or shifts) to communicate with subordinates, supervisors, customers, vendors and any other persons or organization with whom interaction is required to accomplish work and employer goals.

- The employee must be punctual and timely in meeting all requirements of performance, including, but not limited to, attendance standards and work deadlines; beginning and ending assignments on time; and scheduled work breaks, where applicable.
- 10. The employee must be able to work extended hours in an emergency.
- 11. Performs other work which is consistent with the essential functions of the job.
- 12. Performs other duties as assigned.
