

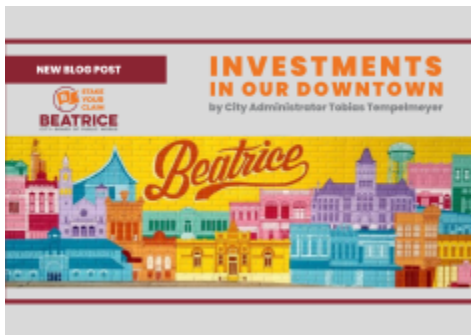

Grants have played a vital role in accomplishing both large and small projects in Beatrice. For decades the City has used grants to improve our community.

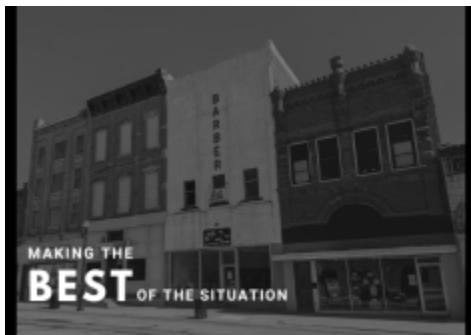
